



THE FOUNDATION

The Foundation "Banca del Monte di Lombardia", is an Institution of banking origin, that was established in 1992 in Pavia, Italy. The Foundation pursues goals of public and social value in the fields of scientific research, education, art and health. Its main aim is to provide assistance and financial aid to residents of the Lombard Region. Thus, the Foundation contributes to the civil, cultural, economic and social development of Lombardy.

The Foundation primarily operates its own programs, but it also cooperates with other private or public partners. The Foundation also funds and supports various initiatives promoted by third parties. A set of Regulations specify the criteria to be followed for the approval and adjudication of a project.

THE "PROGETTO PROFESSIONALITA' IVANO BECCHI"

Established in 1999, the "Professionalità Ivano Becchi" Project is a yearly initiative organized and funded by our Foundation that aims to give bright young professionals the opportunity to deepen their knowledge in their respective fields.

This goal is pursued by financing "ad hoc" training programs to be carried out in Universities, Enterprises, Research Institutions and in Public Administration, anywhere in the world.

Throughout the training period, the Foundation provides trainees with all-inclusive financial support, including insurance expenses.

The maximum duration of the training period is six months. Each candidate who passes the selection process carried out by the Management Committee - made up of Members elected by the Council of the Foundation - is assigned a Tutor. During the training period, the grantee shall keep in regular contact regularly with his/her Tutor and shall produce a Quarterly Report about his/her activities. In addition, a Final Report shall be endorsed by the Training Host and by the Tutor.

At the end of his/her training program, the grantee shall produce a detailed paper describing the contents and results of his/her training. The Tutor draws up his judgement of the training, which is then submitted to the Committee for final evaluation.
